(C) Qualified students from the Open Written test will be called for In-person interviews.

(D) Class 12th marks for engineering aspirants should be: 75 % (for GEN/OBC Candidates) & 65 % (SC/ST/PH).

(E)Class 12th marks for medical aspirants should be 50% for GEN & 40% for OBC, SC, ST & PH.
